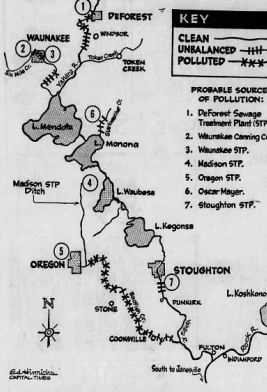


Last of Three Articles on Water Pollution

City, Area Sewage Exacts Heavy Toll on Rock Drainage Basin

By BOB TURQUOY Water pollution in Madison usually brings to mind certain spots of Madison's sewage treatment plant.

But in many instances the water has already been polluted before it enters Madison's lakes, and certainly is polluted when it flows south from Madison's sewage treatment plant.

What sort of things does one measure to determine the extent of pollution in a stream? One measure is the amount of oxygen from water, so the measurement of dissolved oxygen (DO) is a useful index.

Starbuck Creek, which flows into Lake Monona in the Rock Drainage Basin, shows signs of being unbalanced. The probable polluter is Oscar Mayer and Co.

Although the natural pollution-bearing capacity of a stream usually results in a recovery of a mile from the pollution source, the cumulative effect of pollution in the lower Rock River Drainage Basin is likely to be significant.
