Dear Captain Lampe:

I would like to thank you and the other National Guard representatives for meeting with Mike Schmoller and I on October 16, 1995 to discuss the remediation of petroleum contamination in the vicinity of the POL yard, Truax Field.

In brief summary, it is our understanding that the National Guard has prioritized funds for remediation projects using a risk based system. This system ranks the POL yard as a medium priority and funding is presently not scheduled to be available until at least Fiscal Year 1999. Replacement of the POL yard is not scheduled to occur until approximately 2002. The Department strongly believes that active remediation is necessary for this site and that, at a minimum, interim groundwater remediation efforts should begin sometime next year.

We have granted your request for an additional 30 days to develop an evaluation of remedial action alternatives and an implementation schedule for the remediation of this site. We look forward to the receipt of this proposal by November 17th, 1995.
