### Schering Corp. Will Acquire ASL Firm Here

American Scientific Laboratories, Inc., 800 N. Sherman st., Madison, will acquire Schering Corp. (Franklin, N. J.) on Jan. 1, 1959.

An agreement for the acquisition was announced jointly today by Robert D. White, 300 Laurel Lane, president of American Scientific Laboratories, and Francis C. Brown, president of Schering.

ASL will operate as a wholly owned subsidiary of Schering and continue under its present name, equipment and personnel and its present Madison location. Its management includes White as president, Kenneth T. White, executive vice president, and Dr. Philip C. White, vice president and director of research.

The agreement has been approved by the boards of directors of both companies and by stockholders of the Wisconsin corporation. The acquisition will result in an increase of about 100,000 shares of common stock. ASL has a net worth of \$1,000,000.
