## RE: Reinspection of human health hazard at 1902 Tennyson Ln, Madison WI

Dear Mr. Keller

On Friday November 18 2011, Dave Radisewitz and Brandon Macomber of our office made a reinspection of your property at 1902 Tennyson Ln. Will Erpenbach was not onsite at the agreed time but gave verbal permission over the phone for Dave and Brandon to proceed with their reinspection. The report of their reinspection is attached.

Based on the findings from Friday, I am referring this case to the Madison City Attorney's office for action. In our orders issued September 28 2011. You were ordered to accomplish the following within 30 days:

- 1. Have a complete inspection performed of the facility by a hazardous materials professional, including a full inventory of the hazardous materials/waste in the facility.
- 2. Properly dispose of or remove the hazardous materials/waste from the facility.

According to the report, some action was taken to remove suspect materials from the site but no documentation of an inventory has been provided and suspect materials continue to be available on site to those who access the property either legally or illegally.
